Cedar Hill, NTTA Work Together to Make Getting a TollTag Convenient

Plano, TX – Residents of Dallas County have an additional place to sign up for a TollTag now that the City of Cedar Hill has joined the North Texas Tollway Authority's (NTTA) Third Party Vendor Program.

The program's official launch follows Tuesday's grand opening of Cedar Hill's Government Center located at 285 Uptown Blvd. Cedar Hill now joins more than 70 other locations where motorists can sign up for TollTags. For a complete listing of all locations, visit www.ntta.org.

"We are pleased to welcome Cedar Hill into our Third Party Vendor Program," said Clayton Howe, NTTA assistant executive director of operations. "Through our Third Party Vendor Program, we are able to provide convenient access for motorists to sign up and enjoy the convenience of a TollTag. The program also allows the NTTA to build partnerships with municipalities within our service area."

TollTags allow for improved mobility, fuel efficiency and safety on the roads. They also provide customers with a cost savings of up to 45 percent and can work on any toll road in Texas. Customers whose accounts are backed with a credit or debit card can also use their TollTags for parking and pass through at D/FW International Airport, and all parking at Dallas Love Field.

The North Texas Tollway Authority, a political subdivision of the state of Texas, is authorized to acquire, construct, maintain, repair and operate turnpike projects in the north Texas region. Wageman; Vice Chairman Victor Vandergriff; and Directors Kenneth Barr, Gary Base, Bob Day, David Denison, Michael Nowels, Bob Shepard and Alan E. Sims.

The NTTA serves Collin, Dallas, Denton and Tarrant counties and is responsible for the NTTA System, consisting of the Dallas North Tollway, President George Bush Turnpike, 121 Tollway, Addison Airport Toll Tunnel, Lewisville Lake Toll Bridge and the Mountain Creek Lake Bridge. The NTTA is able to raise capital for construction projects through the issuance of turnpike revenue bonds. NTTA toll projects are not a part of the state highway system and receive no direct tax funding. Tolls are collected to repay debt and to operate and maintain the roadways.
