Outreach efforts aimed at contracting opportunities

Plano, TX – The North Texas Tollway Authority (NTTA) will hold a Vendor Outreach Symposium (VOS) in Dallas on Thursday, Oct. 22, in an effort to increase outreach efforts and engage disadvantaged minority, women and small business in the process of doing business with the NTTA.

The symposium will be held from 2 to 4 p.m. at the Bill Priest Institute, located at 1402 Corinth Street in Dallas.

“This symposium will help ensure that vendors and businesses across the North Texas area are aware of how to maximize the various opportunities with the NTTA,” said NTTA Business Diversity Director Anthony Coleman.

About the NTTA

The North Texas Tollway Authority, a political subdivision of the state of Texas, is authorized to acquire, construct, maintain, repair and operate turnpike projects in the north Texas region. The nine-member governing board is comprised of Chairman Paul N. Wageman; Vice Chairman Victor Vandergriff; and Directors Kenneth Barr, Bob Day, David Denison, Bill Moore, Michael Nowels, Bob Shepard and Alan E. Sims.

The NTTA serves Collin, Dallas, Denton and Tarrant counties and is responsible for the NTTA System, consisting of the Dallas North Tollway, President George Bush Turnpike, Sam Rayburn Tollway, Addison Airport Toll Tunnel, Lewisville Lake Toll Bridge and the Mountain Creek Lake Bridge. The NTTA is able to raise capital for construction projects through the issuance of turnpike revenue bonds. NTTA toll projects are not a part of the state highway system and receive no direct tax funding. Tolls are collected to repay debt and to operate and maintain the roadways.
