

How to use the NTTA's Trip Rate Charts

The NTTA has adopted distance-influenced tolling that better reflects the distance you travel on our toll roads. Rates at all gantries have been calculated based upon distance. This tolling plan is considered more equitable – you pay for how far you drive. This tolling method is consistent with the tolling plan on the Sam Rayburn Tollway.

The NTTA's trip rate charts will help you calculate the cost of tolls on your trip. Simply select your starting point on the left side of the chart, and find your destination across the top of the chart. Your trip rate is the point where the two lines intersect.

NOTE: TollTag rates on the Mountain Creek Lake Bridge, Addison Airport Tunnel and the Lewisville Lake Toll Bridge will remain the same. Rates for a one-way trip are as follows:

Mountain Creek Lake Bridge	TollTag \$0.50	Cash \$0.75
Addison Airport Tunnel	TollTag \$0.50	Cash \$0.75
Lewisville Lake Toll Bridge	TollTag \$1.00	ZipCash \$1.50
