



Lane/Ramp Closures Scheduled on the Sam Rayburn Tollway (SRT)

(All closures are for construction work unless otherwise noted)

Daily through Saturday, Nov. 7

- Various lanes north- and southbound on Hardin Boulevard between SRT frontage roads closed, 7 a.m.—5 p.m.
- Various lanes north- and southbound on Stacy Road and Lake Forest Drive between the SRT frontage roads closed, 9 a.m.— 4 p.m. (One lane will remain open in each direction)
- North- and southbound U-turns at Stacy Road and Lake Forest Drive closed 24 hours a day.

Lane/Ramp Closures Scheduled on the President George Bush Turnpike (PGBT)

(All closures are for construction work unless otherwise noted)

Daily through Friday, Nov. 6

Right lane southbound from just north of the Belt Line Road Main Lane Toll Plaza to the Belt Line Road Main Lane Toll Plaza closed, 9 a.m.—3 p.m. (Lane striping)

Daily through Nov. 25

Northbound exit ramp to Las Colinas Boulevard closed 24 hours a day.

Las Colinas Boulevard bridge closed for renovations

The Las Colinas Boulevard bridge over the PGBT is closed for renovations and will remain closed for the remainder of 2009. Motorists heading southbound on the service road will be detoured to North MacArthur Boulevard, where they will be able to make a U-turn and then access eastbound Las Colinas Boulevard. Motorists heading northbound on the service road will be detoured to Riverside Drive, where they will be able to make a U-turn and then access westbound Las Colinas Boulevard.

Eastern Extension of the PGBT in Sachse

Expect Delays at Old Miles Road at Eastern Extension from now through November

Flagger-controlled equipment will be crossing at the PGBT Eastern Extension and Old Miles Road from 9 a.m. to 6:30 p.m. weekdays. Saturday work will be from 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., if needed.

Miles Road bridge traffic to switch sides by January 2010

Last spring, contractors switched both lanes of traffic to the northbound side of the four-lane divided Miles Road where it crosses the future PGBT Eastern Extension in Sachse. This change allows the contractor to work on the southbound side of the road, which will become a bridge over the future tollway. Traffic flow will remain in this pattern until the first of the year when two-way traffic will be moved to the new pavement so work can be done on the southbound side of the bridge.

Eastern Extension of the PGBT in Rowlett

Changes at Kirby Road between SH 66 and Main Street Continue through Middle of November

Kirby Road between State Highway 66 and Main Street is now reduced to one lane in each direction until approximately mid-November. This temporary traffic pattern will allow crews to add temporary widening in preparation for future traffic switches.

Now through January 2010

Valencia Drive at Liberty Grove Road continues to be closed to allow construction of the turnpike's northbound frontage road. Effective in September 2009, Baffin Bay Drive also was closed, limiting access to the Mariner's Cove subdivision from Liberty Grove Road to Royal Bay Drive only. A temporary traffic signal installed at Liberty Grove and Royal Bay is intended to enhance the flow and safety of local traffic. The northbound frontage road is scheduled to be opened to traffic in early 2010.

Eastern Extension of the PGBT in Garland

Temporary Lane Closures Near Firewheel Town Center, Nightly through Thursday, Nov. 5

The frontage roads and ramps where the President George Bush Turnpike intersects with State Highway 78, near Firewheel Town Center, will experience various temporary lane closures overnight each night through Thursday, Nov. 5 from 8 p.m. until 5 a.m. the following morning. These closures will allow crews to complete temporary striping and concrete barrier installation.

Motorists Travelling from Bush Turnpike to U.S. 78 North- and Southbound Now Using Same Exit Ramp

All eastbound President George Bush Turnpike (PGBT) traffic going north or south onto State Highway (SH) 78 are now using the same exit ramp. Northbound traffic will continue to utilize the existing loop ramp. Southbound traffic now utilizes temporary asphalt pavement, where they will be able to turn left (south) onto SH 78 at an intersection where a temporary signal has been installed. This traffic pattern could last through mid-March.
