NTTA Adds Additional Places to Get a TollTag in Tarrant County

Plano, TX – Tarrant County residents have several new places to sign up for a TollTag now that the City of Forest Hill and the Tarrant County Tax Assessor's Office have joined the North Texas Tollway Authority's (NTTA) Third Party Vendor Program.

Motorists can sign-up for or get a TollTag at the City of Forest Hill's offices located at 6800 Forest Hill Drive. The city can also be reached by calling 817-568-3000.

Through the Third Party Vendor Program, the NTTA is able to provide convenient access for motorists to sign up for a TollTag. The program allows the NTTA to build partnerships with municipalities and service providers within our service area, as well as provide customers with transportation information on projects and toll road programs in North Texas.

Motorists can also sign up for TollTags with the NTTA Tag Wagon, a mobile registration outlet that can be found at local special events and festivals in your community. The Tag Wagon is

also available to area businesses for office visits to assist customers in obtaining a TollTag. Businesses wishing to schedule a visit should call 214-461-2091.

About the NTTA

The North Texas Tollway Authority, a political subdivision of the state of Texas, is authorized to acquire, construct, maintain, repair and operate turnpike projects in the north Texas region. The nine-member governing board is comprised of Chairman Paul N. Wageman; Vice Chairman Victor Vandergriff; and Directors Kenneth Barr, Gary Base, Bob Day, David Denison, Michael Nowels, Bob Shepard and Alan E. Sims.

The NTTA serves Collin, Dallas, Denton and Tarrant counties and is responsible for the NTTA System, consisting of the Dallas North Tollway, President George Bush Turnpike, Sam Rayburn Tollway, Addison Airport Toll Tunnel, Lewisville Lake Toll Bridge and the Mountain Creek Lake Bridge. The NTTA is able to raise capital for construction projects through the issuance of turnpike revenue bonds. NTTA toll projects are not a part of the state highway system and receive no direct tax funding. Tolls are collected to repay debt and to operate and maintain the roadways.
