NTTA Board Reelects Chairman and Vice Chairman

Plano, TX – At its regularly scheduled meeting on Wednesday, Sept. 17, the North Texas Tollway Authority (NTTA) Board of Directors, by unanimous votes, reelected Paul N. Wageman and Victor Vandergriff to chairman and vice chairman, respectively.

Collin County appointed Wageman in September of 2000. He has served as Chairman since September of 2006. He also serves as Chairman of the board's System Projects and Operations Committee.

Mr. Wageman, a shareholder resident in the Dallas office of lawfirm Winstead PC, counsels clients on corporate and governmental matters.

Wageman's civic involvement has included service on the board of directors of the North Texas Commission, where he was active in promoting regional cooperation through public/private sector initiatives, particularly in the area of transportation. He was the Lieutenant Governor's appointee to the Texas Sunset Advisory Commission serving a two-year term commencing in 1991. Wageman is a former president and member of the board of directors of the Dallas Assembly and previously served on the Board of Directors of the Greater Dallas Chamber of Commerce.

Vandergriff, a Tarrant County appointee, has served on the NTTA's board since September of 2007. He also serves as chairman of the board's Legislative Committee.

Vandergriff is the Vice President of the Van Tuyl Group, the largest private retail automotive group in the United States. His duties include the oversight of the Vandergriff dealerships in Arlington, Texas.

In addition to his business interests, Vandergriff is an attorney specializing in business development and legislative issues. His current civic and community activities include serving on the Planning and Zoning Commission for the city of Arlington as its chair; vice-chairman of the Downtown Arlington Management Corporation, the organization responsible for spearheading the redevelopment of Arlington's downtown district; and as a member of the board of directors of the Arlington Chamber of Commerce Foundation.

About the NTTA

The North Texas Tollway Authority, a political subdivision of the state of Texas, is authorized to acquire, construct, maintain, repair and operate turnpike projects in the North Texas region. The nine-member governing board is comprised of Chairman Paul N. Wageman; Vice Chairman Victor Vandergriff; and Directors Kenneth Barr, Gary Base, Bob Day, David Denison, Michael Nowels, Bob Shepard, and Alan E. Sims.

The NTTA serves Collin, Dallas, Denton and Tarrant counties and is responsible for the NTTA System, consisting of the Dallas North Tollway, President George Bush Turnpike, Addison Airport Toll Tunnel, Lewisville Lake Toll Bridge and the Mountain Creek Lake Bridge. The NTTA is able to raise capital for construction projects through the issuance of turnpike revenue bonds. NTTA toll projects are not a part of the state highway system and receive no direct tax funding. Tolls are collected to repay debt and to operate and maintain the roadways.
