NOTICE OF VEHICLE BAN ORDER AND INTENT TO IMPOUND

The NTTA's determination that you are a Habitual Violator* pursuant to subsection 372.106(a) of the Transportation Code is final and thus subjects you to habitual violator remedies ("Remedies") under Transportation Code Chapter 372, Subchapter C.

Remedies include a vehicle registration block on your vehicle, an order prohibiting your vehicle from operating on any NTTA toll highway, bridge or tunnel ("Order"), issuance of a traffic citation or arrest for operating your vehicle in violation of the Order, and the impoundment of your vehicle on a second or subsequent violation of the Order.

This Order is effective ten (10) days from the date shown above. You are strongly encouraged to contact NTTA to settle your account immediately to avoid these Remedies.

Once the Order is in effect you are prohibited from operating or allowing another person to operate the vehicle(s) registered in your name on any NTTA toll highway, bridge or tunnel. A person who operates a vehicle on any NTTA toll highway, bridge or tunnel in violation of an Order commits an offense and may be subject to issuance of a citation or arrest, and prosecution for a Class C misdemeanor, which could result in a fine of up to \$500. Upon a second or subsequent violation of the Order, NTTA may impound your vehicle. **Once your vehicle has been impounded, your vehicle will only be released after settlement with the NTTA of all outstanding tolls and fees and payment of all towing, storage and impoundment charges.**

- Present this Order and Notice or your license plate number to the Customer Service Specialist located at:

Or, call NTTA Customer Service at 972-818-6882 during normal business hours.
- Pay outstanding tolls and fees with cash, money order or credit card. *A payment plan may be available with the opening of a TollTag account.* The vehicle storage facility operator will not accept payment of tolls or fees.
- The NTTA Customer Service Specialist will provide you a release receipt to present to the vehicle storage facility operator. Upon paying the required fees, your vehicle will be released. NTTA is not responsible for setting or collecting such fees or releasing your vehicle.
- The vehicle storage facility operator has lawful authority to dispose of vehicles if not promptly retrieved. For more information, see Texas Occupations Code, Section 2303.157.

*A Habitual Violator is a registered owner of a vehicle who was issued at least two written notices of nonpayment that contained in aggregate 100 or more events of nonpayment within a period of one year.
