II. STATEMENT OF SERVICES TO BE PERFORMED: (Continued from Page 1)

The Department plans to provide technical staff and support to measure noise levels at nine sites along the east side of the Dallas North Tollway between Forest Lane and Harvest Hill Road and to model future noise levels at these same locations. Both peak and off-peak traffic levels will be used to characterize existing traffic noise levels every two hours between 8:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m.. The equivalent noise level (Leq) and maximum noise level (Lmax) will be measured over a 15 minute time period and traffic counts will be conducted simultaneously including the categorization of vehicle types and direction of flow. The noise data (Leq) will be printed as a graphical time history and also as an amplitude distribution. The noise instrument used will be a Metrosonics 308 which is a Type 2 instrument. Future noise levels for the designated design year will be modeled using the Federal Highway Administration's Stamina 2.0/Optima computer programs and a report will be generated on the results of this analysis. Measurements will not be made when windspeeds are greater than 20 miles per hour or when the pavement is wet. Weather observations will be acquired at the nearest local airport. The Texas Turnpike Authority traffic volume tapes will be used in conjunction with traffic counts done manually to assess traffic flow. In the noise report recommendations will be made for noise barriers if they are deemed feasible and reasonable in accordance with FHWA and Departmental policy and guidance.

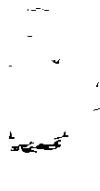
