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## PRESIDENT GEORGE BUSH TURNPIKE ADDITIONAL LANES NOW OPEN TO TRAFFIC



**PLANO, TEXAS – May 2, 2022** – The North Texas Tollway Authority (NTTA) has opened additional lanes in each direction of the President George Bush Turnpike (PGBT) between State Highway 183 and Interstate 20 (I-20) in Grand Prairie.

This completes expansion of the PGBT from State Highway 78 in Garland to I-20 in Grand Prairie.

“We continue to expand and improve so our customers will experience less congestion as they travel on the NTTA system of roadways,” said Elizabeth Mow, NTTA Assistant Executive Director of Infrastructure.

Over the past several years, NTTA has invested in expanding the PGBT, the Sam Rayburn Tollway and the Dallas North Tollway. Additional lanes provide travel options for the rapidly expanding North Texas population.

NTTA is composed of member counties Dallas, Denton, Collin and Tarrant. It also serves Ellis and Johnson counties. NTTA owns and operates the Dallas North Tollway, President George Bush Turnpike, Sam Rayburn Tollway, Addison Airport Toll Tunnel, Lewisville Lake Toll Bridge, Mountain Creek Lake Bridge, Chisholm Trail Parkway, and 360 Tollway. It raises capital for construction projects through the issuance of turnpike revenue bonds. NTTA toll projects are not a part of the state highway system and receive no direct tax funding. Tolls are collected to repay debt and to operate and maintain the roadways.

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
