

Dallas North Tollway Phase 4 & 5

The future Dallas North Tollway Phase 4 & 5 project will extend an additional 18 miles north of U.S. 380, where it currently ends. When this expansion is complete, it will provide a direct link between downtown Dallas and growing areas in Collin, Denton and Grayson counties. The project is currently in the planning stages.

While DNT 4 & 5 is in the planning stages, we'll share some facts and updates on other area projects.

Did you know TxDOT is working to expand U.S. 380 from west of CR 26 (*the Denton/Collin County Line*) to east of Preston Road to add lane capacity and access roads?

As part of this project, TxDOT is also updating the DNT/U.S. 380 intersection to improve traffic flow.
