

Dallas North Tollway Phase 4

SPRING 2022

The Dallas North Tollway (DNT) Phase 4 project will extend the tollway 13.7 miles north of US 380. When this extension is complete, it will provide a direct link between downtown Dallas and the growing communities in Collin and Denton counties.

Proposed Grayson County Tollway	A Grayson County Regional Mobility Authority project that could extend the toll road into Grayson County (not an NTTA project)	

RECENT PROGRESS

- Phase 4A: Deck pours were completed for the mainlane bridges for the DNT extension over US 380. Retaining walls for the new northbound ramps are under construction
- Phase 4A: Design of the DNT 4A mainlane extension from US 380 to FM 428 began
- Phase 4B Frontage Road: Grading slopes and ditches outside the roadway between CR 8 and CR 60 is nearing completion. Excavation between CR 8 and FM 428 has begun

WHAT'S NEXT?

- Phase 4A: Crews will continue work on mainlane retaining walls and ramp paving for the DNT extension over US 380
- Phase 4A: Design of the DNT 4A mainlanes will continue
- Phase 4B Frontage Road: Grading outside the roadway between CR 8 and CR 60 will be completed. Construction of frontage road between FM 428 and the Grayson County line continues
- Coordination with stakeholders and partners continues
