

# President George Bush Turnpike Widening Project

SPRING 2022

The President George Bush Turnpike (PGBT) has been widened to four lanes in each direction to increase capacity between State Highway (SH) 78 in Garland and Belt Line Road in Irving and between SH 183 in Irving and I-20 in Grand Prairie.

All widening projects along the PGBT are complete.

I-35E to Belt Line Road in Irving	Construction began in August 2019; Opened to traffic October 2021	
SH 183 to I-20 in Grand Prairie	Construction began in December 2019; Opened to traffic April 2022	

## RECENT PROGRESS

- I-35E to Belt Line Road (Irving): East and westbound fourth lanes opened to traffic in October 2021. Work is now complete
- SH 183 to I-20: Crews placed concrete traffic rail, installed signs and placed pavement markings. The new lanes opened to traffic in April

## WHAT'S NEXT?

- SH 183 to I-20: Finishing work will continue into summer
