

Trinity Parkway

The proposed Trinity Parkway will connect Interstate 35E to U.S. 175. The project will provide a new approximately 9-mile relief route around the west and south sides of Dallas' central business district. The project is currently in the preliminary engineering stage.

WHAT HAPPENED RECENTLY?

- The Federal Highway Administration delivered the Trinity Parkway Record of Decision April 2, 2015, regarding the development of the preferred Alternative 3C alignment.
- The Texas Department of Transportation completed design for the portion of Trinity Parkway from U.S.175/State Highway 310 to I-45 as Phase I of the S.M. Wright project.
- On March 21, 2016, the technical advisory committee for Trinity Parkway briefed the city of Dallas Transportation and Trinity River Project Committee.
