Why is North Texas Tollway Authority (NTTA) partially closing the Scott Mill Road and Kelly Boulevard bridges over the President George Bush Turnpike (PGBT) this summer?

The short answer: Rehabilitation work at each end of the bridges.

How will this affect traffic from June to mid-August?

As a result of this construction, the current number of travel lanes will be reduced to create space for the work.

When will this work occur?

Beginning June 1, 2019, and weather permitting, temporary lane striping for the new traffic patterns will be added and crews will begin their work. These traffic patterns will change in mid-July when work is completed on one side and traffic is switched to the other lanes. Both bridges will be fully opened to traffic before the beginning of the Carrollton-Farmers Branch ISD school year in August in their original configuration.

Partial closures of Scott Mill Road and Kelly Boulevard bridges over PGBT summer 2019

Important things for our neighbors to know:

Scott Mill Road bridge over PGBT:

- Partially closed from early June through mid-August, 2019.
- All southbound lanes will be closed.
- One northbound lane will remain open.
- This traffic pattern will change in mid-July when traffic is switched to the other lanes.

A detour will be available to drivers going south on Scott Mill Road:

- Motorists traveling southbound on Scott Mill Road will turn right onto westbound Trinity Mills Road (PGBT frontage road) and left onto Josey Lane.
- Motorists then turn left again onto eastbound Trinity Mills Road (PGBT frontage road) and continue to their destination.

Kelly Boulevard bridge over PGBT:

- Partially closed from early June through mid-August, 2019.
- Northbound Kelly Boulevard will change from four to two northbound lanes.
- Southbound drivers will use the other one lane in order to continue to their destination.
- This traffic pattern will change in mid-July when traffic is switched to lanes on the other side.
