
Local events not affected by construction

Spring marks the beginning of 5ks, marathons and family friendly festivals and events. To ensure minimal construction impact on these popular events, the NTTA has been working with organizers of Fort Worth's signature events, including the Cowtown Marathon, the Fort Worth Zoo, National Multiple Sclerosis Society, the March of Dimes and Mayfest, Inc. and making adjustments when possible.

Interstate 30 making way for the Chisholm Trail Parkway

Did you know that crews working on the Chisholm Trail Parkway will reconstruct Interstate 30 from Summit Avenue to the Trinity River? As a part of construction, I-30 will be reconstructed up to 160 feet south of its current location.

To give you a better visual, the future westbound I-30 main lanes near Forest Park Boulevard will be constructed where the eastbound main lanes are currently located. The work is necessary as crews begin to construct the I-30/CTP interchange.

Once completed, the CTP will stretch 27.6 miles between downtown Fort Worth and Cleburne. Motorists will be able to access the parkway from the following locations:
