



DNT PAVEMENT IMPROVEMENTS

Northbound DNT from I-35E to I-635

NTTA is improving the northbound main lanes of the Dallas North Tollway (DNT) from I-35E to I-635 as part of its regularly scheduled maintenance to keep roadways safe. This work will include new driving surface overlay, concrete repairs, drainage improvements and restriping.

Message boards will be placed nearby to alert drivers of the closure. Please use caution in the construction area, including observing speed limits and safety signage.

Thanks for your patience as we work to maintain our roads at the high quality our customers expect.

What's Complete?

- Replacement of the driving surface from Lomo Alto Dr. to University Blvd.

What's Next?

- Milling, or removal of the driving surface, is underway from University Blvd. to Royal Ln. Once milling is complete, crews will complete concrete pavement repairs then place the new driving surface.






