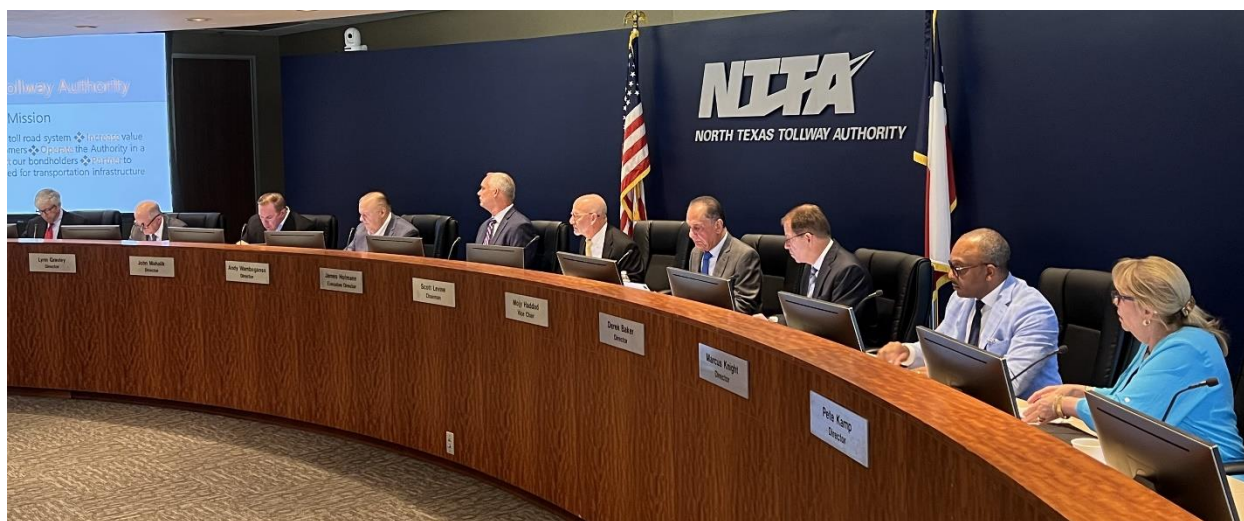


NTTA BOARD ELECTS OFFICERS

NTTA owns and operates the Dallas North Tollway, President George Bush Turnpike, Sam Rayburn Tollway, Addison Airport Toll Tunnel, Lewisville Lake Toll Bridge, Mountain Creek Lake Bridge, Chisholm Trail Parkway, and 360 Tollway. The NTTA System is not a part of the state highway system and receives no legislative appropriations. Tolls are collected to repay debt and to operate and maintain the roadways.
