

Why Pay More for Tolls?

Your Pay-Less Checklist



As a TollTag Insider, you know that your small TollTag sticker means big savings – but make sure you’re getting the most savings by following these simple steps:



- Confirm you have a valid credit/debit card saved to your TollTag account. If you don't have a valid payment method on file, you'll receive ZipCash invoices at twice the rate. Don't pay extra – log in to your account at <https://ssptrips.ntta.org> and set your preferred payment method. (While you're there, make sure your contact information is up to date in case we need to contact you regarding your account).

- Ensure your TollTag is properly installed on your windshield behind your rear-view mirror. Watch the instructional video [here](#). Incorrectly installed TollTags may incur a higher toll rate. If you need a replacement TollTag, request one for free by calling NTTA Customer Service at 972-818-6882.



- Sold your vehicle recently? Tolls are charged to the registered owner of a vehicle, so if you traded the vehicle to a dealership, upload a copy of the bill of sale to your TollTag account. If the vehicle was sold to an individual, file a [Vehicle Transfer Notification \(VTN\)](#) with the Texas DMV.
