



# CONSTRUCTION ALERT

## DNT mainlane bridge maintenance will take place between Downtown Dallas and I-635



As part of maintenance on the south end of the Dallas North Tollway (DNT) multiple bridges will be repaired and resurfaced.

**WHY:** This work is part of NTTA's continuing effort to maintain the reliable, high-quality roads our customers expect.

**WHERE:** The DNT mainlane bridges above Harry Hines Blvd., Wycliff Ave., Lemmon Ave., Lovers Ln., Forest Ln. and Inwood Rd. will be repaired this year.

DNT mainlane bridge resurfacing will be completed using a two-lane closure in each direction, so no full closure will be needed. Only one bridge will be closed at a time. Drivers should expect delays during construction.

### WHEN WORK WILL OCCUR:

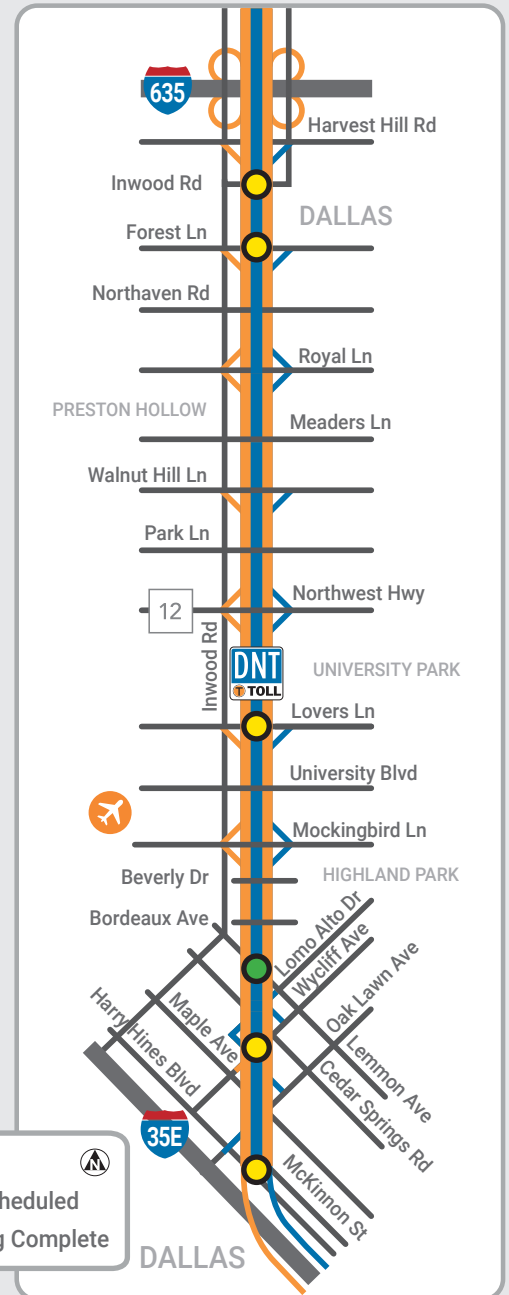
Work began Friday, March 20 at Lemmon Ave. and Wycliff Ave. and will occur most weekends through June 2026. Closures will be continuous each weekend from 10 p.m. Friday to 5 a.m. Monday. Bridge work not completed in spring will be completed this fall.

Traffic Alerts and maps of the area will be shared for each weekend closure with the media and on NTTA's social media pages. *Closures will not occur the first weekend in April.*

All closures are subject to weather conditions and, if necessary, will be postponed.
