

Chisholm Trail Parkway Widening Project

JULY 2026

The Chisholm Trail Parkway (CTP) is being widened from FM 1187 in Tarrant County to US 67 in Johnson County - approximately 13 miles.

This project will include adding two new mainlanes, allowing for two continuous lanes in each direction.

Opening date: Late 2028

RECENT PROGRESS

- Construction activities continue throughout the corridor, including earthwork, drainage, and bridge construction
- Bridge deck work is ongoing at Don Lee Road bridge and CR 904 bridge
- Buffalo Creek bridge and CR 1015 bridge construction is ongoing
- Substructure work is ongoing at Sparks Road, CR 920, and CR 913 bridges

WHAT'S NEXT?

- Continue bridge construction throughout the corridor
- Advance roadway construction, including embankment, subgrade, and paving operations
- Continue drainage installation throughout the corridor
- The southbound CTP entrance ramp from FM 917 will be closed beginning Monday, July 27 through January 2027. Crews will be reconstructing the southbound mainlanes and ramps in this area.
