Southbound DNT from I-635 to I-35E

NTTA is improving the southbound main lanes of the Dallas North Tollway (DNT) from I-635 to I-35E as part of its regularly scheduled maintenance to keep roadways safe. This work will include a new driving surface overlay, concrete repairs, drainage improvements and restriping.

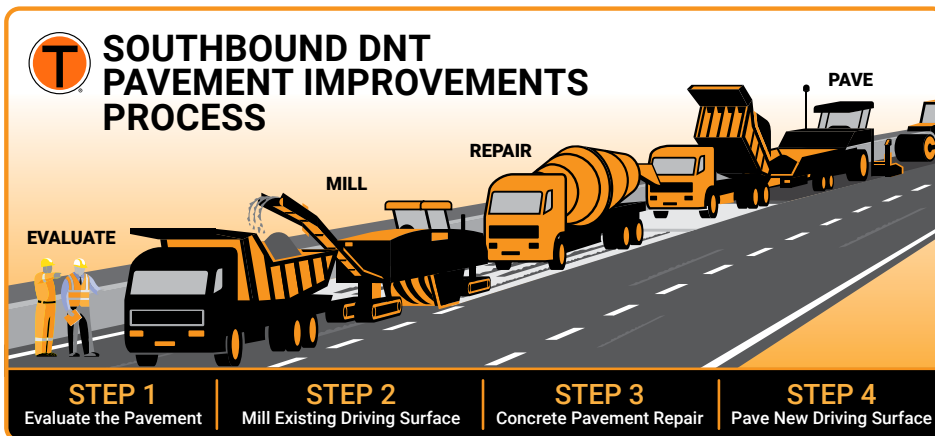
Message boards will be placed nearby to alert drivers of any closures. Please use caution in the construction area, including observing speed limits and safety signage.

Concrete pavement repairs between I-635 and Walnut Hill Ln.



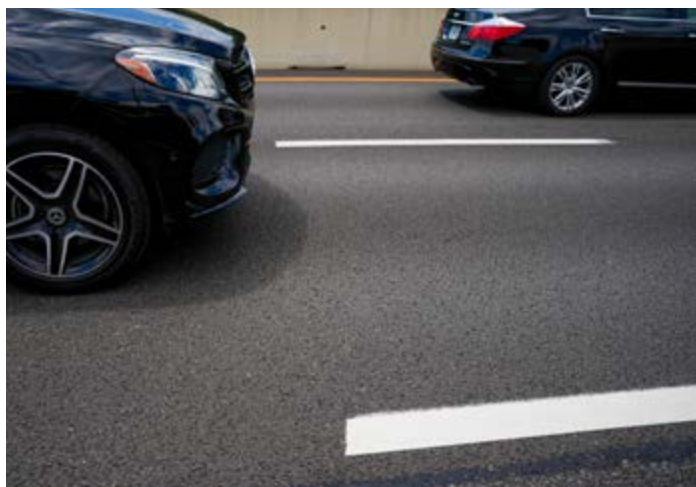

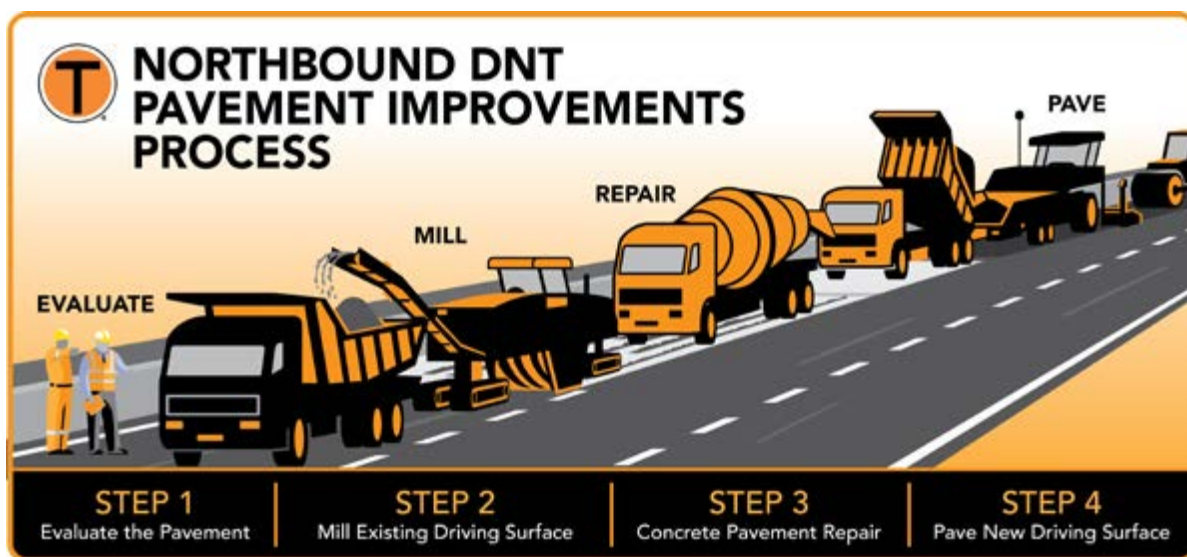
