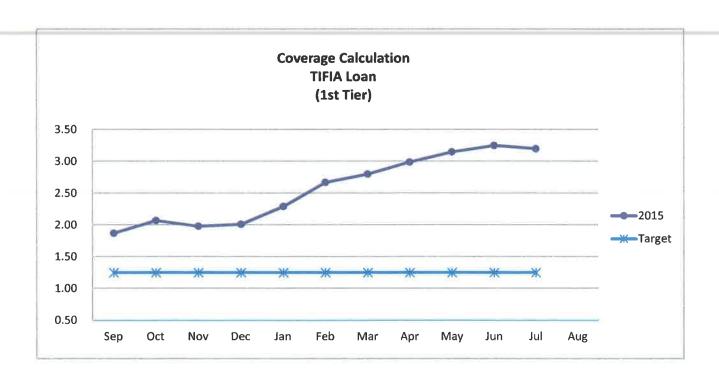

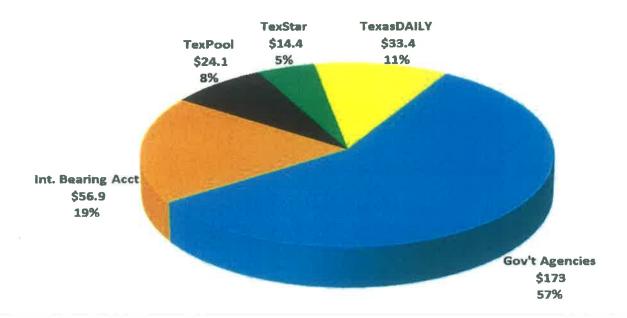




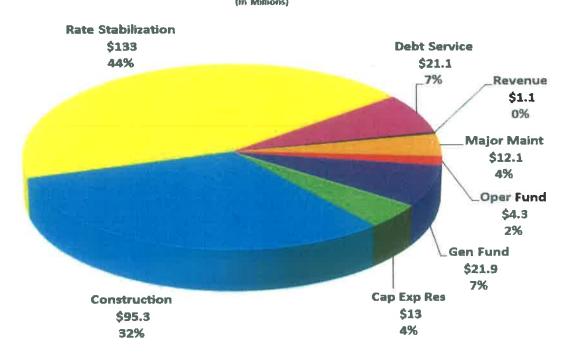




## SPS Portfolio Composition by Type as of 7/31/2015 \$301.8 (In Millions)
